

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, July 11, 2024 at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all Councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00am with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on June 13, 2024 and the Budget Meeting held on June 25, 2024, were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of June was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council approved purchase of concrete parking blocks to be placed in the front of the office building and acknowledged receipt of 4 road closed notices. Council awarded the 10th Annual Bursary of \$2,000 to Callie Smith, recognizing an excellent candidate. Council passed a bylaw and authorized a letter of support to be sent to MLA Daryl Harrison and Premier Scott Moe supporting the Saskatchewan Broadband Action Committee (SBAC) in their efforts in achieving broadband infrastructure parity for all Saskatchewan residents, regardless of address, by 2025. A donation to the Border-Line Housing Company outdoor expansion project was also authorized.

Public Works Supervisor, Armstrong, and Assistant Public Works Supervisor, Mailhiot, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to workshop operation.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20am.
