

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 9, 2025, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with one Councillor absent and Division 2 Vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00am with Reeve Bendtsen presiding.

Minutes of the First Meeting held on December 12, 2024 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of December was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council passed a repealing bylaw, opted out of the MHI Spring Weight Restriction Program, and acknowledged receipt of the Fidelity Bond. Workers compensation coverage was authorized, and requests for proposals for the supply of diesel fuel and for 2025 gravel hauling and spreading were called. Council agreed to allocate the entire population of the RM to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2025 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation. Grants were issued to St. Raphael's Parish Cemetery, the Town of Carnduff Cemetery, and the Dannevirke Lutheran Church Cemetery. Contributions to multiple programs and memberships for 2025 in several organizations were approved. Advertising in local school yearbooks was authorized.

Public Works Supervisor, Armstrong attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to workshop operation.
